

NOTICE OF TARIFF CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2009

1. Increased rates for Wharfage, Wharf Demurrage, Handling, Service and Facilities Charge, Equipment Rental, Passenger Traffic Fee, Fresh Water for Vessels and Security Fee by 4.9%.
2. Increased rates for Dockage by 7.4%
3. Applied a direct pass-through reflecting Longshore contract increases on Man-Hour Rates and Man-Hour Rates for Direct Transfer Log Loading.
4. Revised language in Item 301(F) Dockage Rules – Vessels Making Repair or Alterations:

which reads:

ITEM 301 - DOCKAGE RULES (F) VESSELS MAKING REPAIR OR ALTERATIONS

Vessels at berth, making alterations or repairs, shall pay a minimum of \$287.00 per day dockage or \$3.12 per foot in length overall (LOA) per day, whichever is greater. After the first 24 hours at berth vessels will be charged at ½ the applicable rate per 12 hour period or portion thereof.

ITEM 301 – DOCKAGE RULES (F) VESSELS MAKING REPAIR OR ALTERATIONS

Vessels at berth over 375 feet in length overall (LOA), making alterations or repairs, shall pay dockage of \$3.35 per foot in length overall (LOA) per day. After the first 24 hours at berth, vessels will be charged at one-half (½) the applicable rate per 12 hour period or portion thereof.

Vessels and barges at berth 375 feet in length overall (LOA) or less, making alterations or repairs, shall pay dockage of a minimum of \$163.00 per day or \$1.63 per foot in length overall (LOA) per day, whichever is greater.
