Hangars and Tie Downs

Hangars at Fairchild International Airport consist of the following categories:

• 32 Port owned hangars – 4 buildings East of the Terminal Building

100 Building - 200 Building - 300 Building - 400 Building 38' opening with sliding doors 32' depth 10' door height

• 16 Port owned hangars – the 700 Building adjacent to the aviation fuel tanks

3 - Twin Hangars: 45' opening with sliding doors 42' depth 14' door height 13 - Single Hangars: 42' opening with sliding doors 33' depth 12' door height

• 15 Open Air hangars – the 600 Building adjacent to the aviation fuel tanks

Open hangars and tie down spots are vailable for rent on a daily or monthly rate.

Open hangar tail heights are 10' and 12'.

 - 26 Spaces on the East Parking Apron (East of Terminal Bldg.)
 - 2 4 Corporate Jet Spaces on the Center Parking Apron (West of Terminal Bldg.)
 - 9 Spaces on the West Parking Apron (Adjacent to the fuel tanks)
- Privately Owned Hangars There are four privately owned hangars under the umbrella
 of three Hangar Condominium Associations. These hangars are at times available for
 rent or for sale.
