

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
STUDY OF FORKS INDUSTRIAL PARK AND QUILLAYUTE AIRPORT**

This agreement is executed by and between the Port of Port Angeles, a municipal corporation (Port) and the City of Forks, a *municipal Corporation* (City) to facilitate the economic development of industrial areas on the west end of Clallam County. The parties make an enter into this Interlocal Agreement (Agreement) effective the 15th day of February ~~1999~~, 2000 for the purposes and under the terms contained herein.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a grant from the Community Economic Revitalization Board (CERB) in the amount of \$22,500 to complete a marketing and infrastructure study of the Forks Industrial Park and Quillayute Airport, and

WHEREAS, the City will be required to provide cash and in-kind match in the amount of \$22,500 for this project, and

WHEREAS, the Port is willing to assist the City in meeting the match requirement so that a plan for economic development can be developed for these important industrial areas.

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The City will act as lead agency for the project. The City shall be responsible for reporting expenditures to CERB and satisfying all of the CERB grant requirements, contracting for consulting services, providing direction to the consultant, and for reviewing and accepting the final report.
2. The City will provide the Port with copies of draft reports and will provide the Port with copies of the final report.
3. The Port will contribute up to \$5,000 cash towards the match for the CERB grant. The City will provide the Port with documentation satisfactory to the Port of expenditures for the project and the Port will timely reimburse the City for those expenditures up to \$5,000.
4. If requested by the City, the Port will also provide assistance in review of draft documents, meetings with consultants and other professional assistance.

No amendment to this Agreement shall be effective unless approved and executed by the parties in writing.
