Low Flying Aircraft or Loud Noise Complaint

When reporting a “Low Flying Aircraft” or “Loud Noise Complaint”, the FAA will need the following information to conduct a complete investigation:

1. Description of the aircraft and the registration or tail number (preceded by “N”) (i.e. color, number and placement of wings and engine)
2. The type of aircraft (i.e. jet, helicopter, propeller, seaplane)
3. Street address or cross streets where the event(s) occurred
4. The date and time you experience the event(s)
5. Photo(s) and/or video(s) – if available
