A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Port Angeles adopting an amended Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plan.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on February 27, 2012 after notice as provided by law, on amending the Port Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plan, and;

WHEREAS, after discussion and consideration of the proposed amended Port Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plan, the Commission decided that said amended comprehensive plan should be adopted;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Port Commission of the Port of Port Angeles as follows:

Section 1: That after and pursuant to a public hearing held on February 27, 2012, following notice therefore given as required by law, the Port Commission of the Port of Port Angeles does hereby adopt an amended Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plan in the manner required by law.

<u>Section 2:</u> The purpose in adopting an amended Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plan is to update the Port's role and future direction in providing public park and recreation facilities, under the applicable provisions of State Law (RCW 53.08.260).

Said amended Parks and Recreation Plan is fully set forth in the plan document on file at the Port of Port Angeles Administrative Office.
