## Commissioners' Resolution No. 18-1172

### RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF PORT ANGELES DESIGNATING AN AGENT TO RECEIVE CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES AGAINST THE PORT OF PORT ANGELES

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 4.96.020, the Port Commission (the "Commission") of the Port of Port Angeles (the "Port") is required to appoint an agent to receive any claim for damages made against the Port under Chapter 4.96 RCW, governing claims made for tortious conduct of local governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, by Commissioners' Resolution No. 868, adopted July 23, 2001, the Commission designated the Port's Director of Finance and Administration to receive on behalf of the Port any claim for damages made under Chapter 4.96 RCW; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and necessary to update the Port's designation of its agent to receive damage claims for tortious conduct.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- Designation of Auditor as Agent to Receive Claims for Damages.**  
The Port of Port Angeles Auditor is hereby authorized to receive on behalf of the Port any damage claim for tortious conduct made against the Port under Chapter 4.96 RCW. The Auditor, or the Deputy Auditor in the Auditor's absence, shall be available to receive any such claim for damages during normal business hours at the Port's administration building located at 338 West First Street, Port Angeles, Washington, 98362.
- Rescission of Prior Resolutions.** This Resolution No. 18-1172 supersedes Resolution 868 and all other prior resolutions related to the subject matter hereof, and said prior resolutions are hereby rescinded.
