A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT OF PORT ANGELES WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR COMMUNITY ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION BOARD (CERB) FOR THE MARINE TRADES INDUSTRIAL PARK DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the Community Economic Revitalization Board (CERB) of the State of Washington Department of Community Trade and Economic Development is authorized to make grants and loans for infrastructure for qualified applicants of Washington State Municipalities, including the Port of Port Angeles, located in a designated rural county; and

WHEREAS, CERB is authorized to make grants and loans through the Prospective Development Program; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Port Angeles has an opportunity to develop the Marine Trades Industrial Park at the former K-Ply Mill Site; and

WHEREAS, Existing marine trades businesses that will benefit from this development are key drivers of our local economy and they have the need and capacity to expand and create jobs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT OF PORT ANGELES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Executive Director of the Port of Port Angeles is hereby authorized to submit an application to CERB for \$1,300,000 in loan and/or grant to start development at the Marine Trades Industrial Park.
2. A copy of this resolution shall be submitted with the CERB application.
