Enclosed for your signature are two initial proffered Department of the Army permit forms for your proposal to repair and extend sections of Terminal 2 in Port Angeles Harbor at Port Angeles, Washington as described in the enclosed drawings dated November 15, 2012. If you object to this permit decision, you may submit your objections on the enclosed Notification of Administrative Appeal Options and Process and Request for Appeal form. For your objections to be considered, the appeal form describing your objections must be received in our office within 60 days of the date on the appeal form.

If the entire permit is acceptable, you must sign and date both permit forms and return them in the enclosed envelope. Your copy of the fully executed permit will then be returned to you. The time limit for completing the work at General Condition 1 will be 5 years from the effective date of the permit. You may not modify these permit forms or their accompanying drawings. By signing the permit forms you will be indicating your acceptance of all the permit's general and special conditions some of which require you to take action by specific due dates. The signed permit forms must be returned to us within 90 days from the date of this letter or your application will be canceled.

Since a Department of the Army permit is necessary for this work, do not commence construction before obtaining a valid permit. You can begin the work authorized by this permit only after you have received your copy of the fully executed permit form. ## DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY PERMIT

**Permittee:** Port Angeles, Port of (Terminal 2 Renovation)

Permit No: NWS-2011-240

Issuing Office: Seattle District

NOTE: The term "you" and its derivatives, as used in this permit, means the permittee or any future transferee. The term "this office" refers to the appropriate district or division office of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) having jurisdiction over the permitted activity or the appropriate official of that office acting under the authority of the commanding officer.

You are authorized to perform work in accordance with the terms and conditions specified below.

**Project Description**: Repair and extend sections of Terminal 2 in accordance with the plans and drawings dated November 15, 2012, attached hereto which are incorporated in and made a part of this permit. The purpose of the project is to provide people safe and secure access to and from the Black Ball Ferry.

**Project Location**: In Port Angeles Harbor at 101 East Railroad Avenue, Port Angeles, Clallam County, Washington.

#### Permit Conditions:

#### General Conditions:

1. The time limit for completing the work authorized ends on <u>NOV 2 6 2017</u>. If you find that you need more time to complete the authorized activity, submit your request for a time extension to this office for consideration at least 1 month before the above date is reached.

2. You must maintain the activity authorized by this permit in good condition and in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit. You are not relieved of this requirement if you abandon the permitted activity, although you may make a good faith transfer to a third party in compliance with General Condition 4 below. Should you wish to cease to maintain the authorized activity or should you desire to abandon it without a good faith transfer, you must obtain a modification to this permit from this office, which may require restoration of the area.

3. If you discover any previously unknown historic or archeological remains while accomplishing the activity authorized by this permit, you must immediately notify this office of what you have found. We will initiate the Federal and State coordination required to determine if the remains warrant a recovery effort or if the site is eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places.

4. If you sell the property associated with this permit, you must obtain the signature of the new owner in the space provided and forward a copy of the permit to this office to validate the transfer of this authorization.

5. If a conditioned water quality certification has been issued for your project, you must comply with the conditions specified in the certification as special conditions to this permit. For your convenience, a copy of the certification is attached if it contains such conditions.

6. You must allow representatives from this office to inspect the authorized activity at any time deemed necessary to ensure that it is being or has been accomplished in accordance with the terms and conditions of your permit.

7. After a detailed and careful review of all the conditions contained in this permit, the permittee acknowledges that, although said conditions were required by the Corps, nonetheless the permittee agreed to

those conditions voluntarily to facilitate issuance of the permit; the permittee will comply fully with all the terms of all the permit conditions.

#### **Special Conditions:**

a. You must provide a copy of the permit transmittal letter, the permit form, and drawings to all contractors performing any of the authorized work.

b. The permittee understands and agrees that, if future operations by the United States require the removal, relocation, or other alteration, of the structure or work herein authorized, or if, in the opinion of the Secretary of the Army or his authorized representative, said structure or work shall cause unreasonable obstruction to the free navigation of the navigable waters, the permittee will be required, upon due notice from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, to remove, relocate, or alter the structural work or obstructions caused thereby, without expense to the United States. No claim shall be made against the United States on account of any such removal or alteration.

c. You must implement and abide by the Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements and/or agreements set forth in the Terminal 2 Renovation Biological Evaluation, dated March 2011, and the addendum dated November 2011, in their entirety. The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) concurred with a finding of "may affect, not likely to adversely affect" based on this document on July 19, 2012, (NMFS Reference Number 2012/01646). The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) concurred with a finding of "may affect, not likely to adversely affect" based on November 9, 2012, (USFWS Reference Number 01EWFW00-2012-I-0208). Both agencies will be informed of this permit issuance. Failure to comply with the commitments made in this document constitutes non-compliance with the ESA and your Corps permit. The USFWS/NMFS is the appropriate authority to determine compliance with ESA.

d. In order to meet the requirements of the ESA and for the protection of Puget Sound Chinook and steelhead and Coastal/Puget Sound bull trout and spawning pacific herring, you may conduct the authorized activities from July 16 through February 15 in any year this permit is valid. You shall not conduct work authorized by this permit from February 16 through July 15 in any year this permit is valid.

e. You shall implement and abide by the mitigation plan, *Terminal 2 Renovation Compensatory Mitigation Plan* dated November 2012, and as modified by the permit special conditions. Mitigation shall be constructed within 1 year of the start of the work authorized by the permit, except for concrete rubble and creosote-treated piles shall be removed under the East Pier during that phase of construction, and shoreline plantings will be installed by June 1, 2013.

f. The proposed reporting schedule (Table 5) in the mitigation plan *Terminal 2 Renovation Compensatory Mitigation Plan* dated November 2012, is hereby modified as follows:

- 1. In year 7 and year 10, plant survival (without irrigation) of 100% for trees, 80% for shrubs, 90% for groundcover, or replacement to those standards. Woody vegetation standards must be met without irrigation for two successive growing seasons.
- 2. In years 1 through 10, submit monitoring report to Corps.

g. A status report on the implementation of the authorized work and on the construction of the mitigation shall be submitted annually to the Corps, Seattle District, Regulatory Branch by December 31, each year until mitigation construction is complete as determined by the Corps. This report must prominently display the reference number NWS-2011-240.

h. An as-built mitigation construction report and as-built drawings of the mitigation areas shall be submitted upon completion of mitigation construction, in lieu of the status report described in Special Condition "g." This

report must be submitted to the Corps, Seattle District, Regulatory Branch for review and approval and must prominently display the reference number NWS-2011-240. The year mitigation construction is completed, as determined by the Corps, represents Year 0 for mitigation monitoring.

i. Mitigation monitoring reports shall be submitted annually for monitoring years 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, and 10 to the Corps, Seattle District, Regulatory Branch by December 31, of each monitoring year. Year 1 monitoring will occur at least one year after completion of the mitigation sites as determined by the Corps. All reports must prominently display the reference number NWS-2011-240.

j. Your responsibility to complete the required compensatory mitigation as set forth in Special Conditions "e" through "i" will not be considered fulfilled until you have demonstrated mitigation success and have received written verification from the Corps, Seattle District, Regulatory Branch.

The following Special Condition is being added to the permit to ensure compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.

k. A professional archaeologist must be on-site to monitor for the presence of archaeological resources during the disturbance of soils behind the bulkhead and during the installation of the storm water collection system.

I. If human remains, historic resources, or archaeological resources are encountered during construction, all ground disturbing activities shall cease in the immediate area and you shall immediately (within one business day of discovery) notify the Corps, Seattle District, Regulatory Branch. You shall perform any work required by the Corps in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and Corps regulations.

#### **Further Information:**

1. Congressional Authorities. You have been authorized to undertake the activity described above pursuant to:

- Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbor Act of 1899 (33 U.S.C. 403).
- Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1344).
- Section 103 of the Marine Protection, Research and Sanctuaries Act of 1972 (33 U.S.C 1413).
- 2. Limits of this authorization.

a. This permit does not obviate the need to obtain other Federal, State, or local authorization required by law.

- b. This permit does not grant any property rights or exclusive privileges.
- c. This permit does not authorize any injury to the property or rights of others.
- d. This permit does not authorize interference with any existing or proposed Federal project.

3. Limits of Federal Liability. In issuing this permit, the Federal Government does not assume any liability for the following:

a. Damages to the permitted project or uses thereof as a result of other permitted activities or from natural causes.

Damages to the permitted project or uses thereof as a result of current or future activities undertaken by b. or on behalf of the United States in the public interest.

Damages to persons, property, or to other permitted or unpermitted activities or structures caused by the activity authorized by this permit.

Design or construction deficiencies associated with the permitted work. d.

e. Damage claims associated with any future modification, suspension, or revocation of this permit.

4. Reliance on Applicant's Data. The determination of this office that issuance of this permit is not contrary to the public interest was made in reliance on the information you provided.

Reevaluation of Permit Decision. This office may reevaluate its decision on this permit at any time the 5. circumstances warrant. Circumstances that could require include, but are not limited to, the following:

You fail to comply with the terms and conditions of the permit. a.

b The information provided by you in support of your application proves to have been false, incomplete, or inaccurate (See 4 above).

Significant new information surfaces which this office did not consider in reaching the original public С. interest decision.

Such a reevaluation may result in a determination that it is appropriate to use the suspension, modification, and revocation procedures contained in 33 CFR 325.7 or enforcement procedures such as those contained in 33 CFR 326.4 and 326.5. The referenced enforcement procedures provide for the issuance of an administrative order requiring you to comply with the terms and conditions of your permit and for the initiation of legal action where appropriate. You will be required to pay for any corrective measures ordered by this office, and if you fail to comply with such directive, this office may in certain situations (such as those specified in 33 CFR 209.170) accomplish the corrective measures by contract or otherwise and bill you for the cost.

Extensions. General condition 1 establishes a time limit for the completion of the activity authorized by this 6. permit. Unless there are circumstances requiring either a prompt completion of the authorized activity or a reevaluation of the public interest decision, the Corps will normally give favorable consideration to a request for an extension of this time limit.
