A RESOLUTION TO COMMEMORATE THE 100 YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF THE PORT OF PORT ANGELES.

WHEREAS, on November 7, 1922 the citizens of Clallam County voted to establish the Port of Port Angeles, as the 18th public port in Washington state; and
