The proposed Tariff No. 200 (effective July 1, 2025) revises rates, clarifies terms, and aligns with current regulatory requirements. Updates ensure compliance with Federal Maritime Commission (FMC) standards, the U.S. Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), and Revised Code of Washington State (RCW). This update supports the Port's long-term operational sustainability and market responsiveness.
