A. Clallam County Revenue Advisory Committee - RAC Update

Connie Beauvais provided an update from the latest RAC meeting on June 15th, with the next meeting scheduled for August 17th.

Connie also provided an update on the Amicus Brief and noted the hearing is set for August 31st.

B. DNR & BNR Update

Matt Comisky was unable to attend the meeting. Connie Beauvais noted she attended the last BNR meeting and explained there were paid activists for the More Gooder sale. Paul Jarkiewicz read a report from Bruce Becket who attended the Beneficiary Coalition call.

C. Port Operations Discussion

Chris Hartman provided an update on the log yard project and noted the business is very slow. Paving is scheduled for 9 days in September, and the cofferdam work is scheduled for 6 weeks in October.

The group discussed the weigh scales and the different locations where they could be placed. It was noted that having them on-site at the Log Yard would benefit the Port and its customers. The Port will bring this topic back to the group at the next meeting.
